

# **Remote Learner News**

Teachers are working hard to engage all of our students and ensure that they are understanding the content. In order to be successful with this, teachers need to interact with students to check their understanding. We have found that students who have their cameras on, engage in the chat and/or unmute when asked a question are doing much better in their classes and on assignments.

If your student doesn't resond to their teachers verbally or in the Zoom chat, the teacher will contact you to share concerns and problem solve the issues. If the lack of engagement continues, the teachers will reach out to the grade-level administrator and will help develop a more detailed plan which will involve attendance conversations. Please let us know if you have any questions.



## **Boys Basketball**
