We have a School Store to spend the Panther Paws you earn.

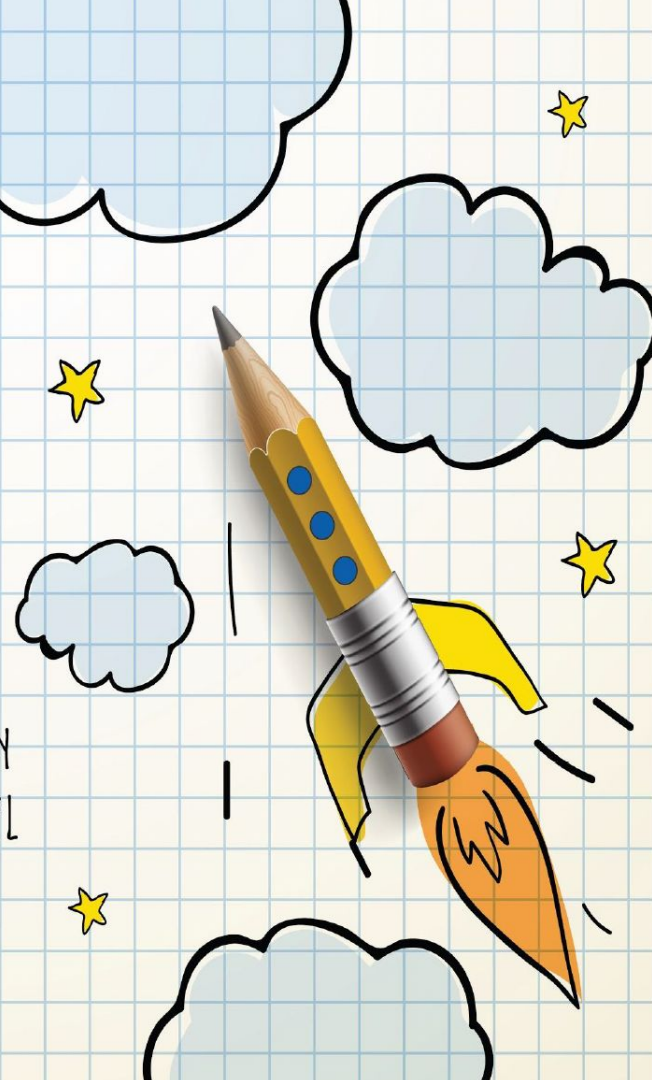

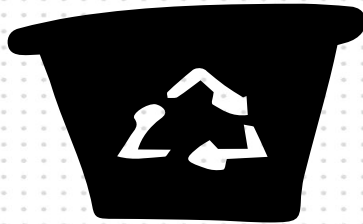
Before School Procedures

1. Boys and Girls Club Power Hour starts at 7:00am.
2. If not in Power Hour, students should not arrive until 7:30 am.
3. 6th graders enter the building through Door 25.
4. Students will sit in their grade level hallway until 7:55am.
5. Students will be dismissed at 7:55 to go to lockers.
6. Classes start promptly at 8:00am.



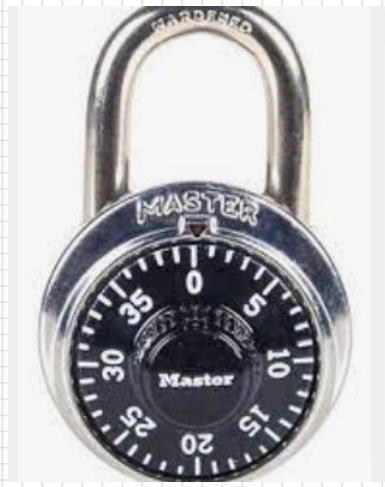
Breakfast Procedures

Student Lockers

3. Students only use their lockers at the start and end of the day unless they need to get PE clothes or their lunch box.

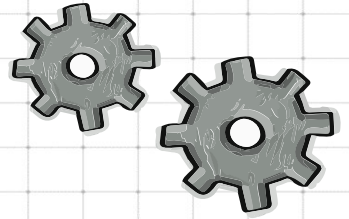


Student Chromebooks

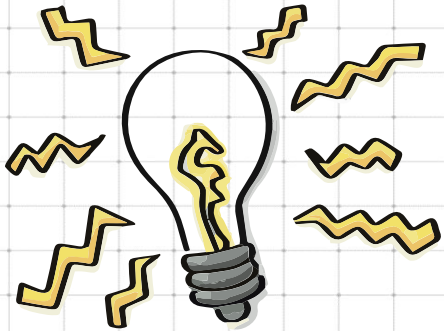
1. Every 6th grade will be issued a Chromebook.

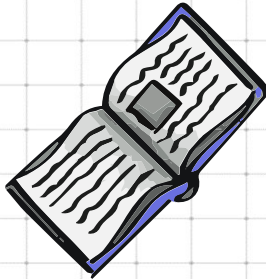
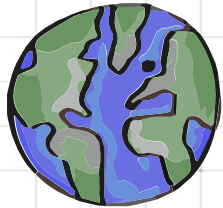

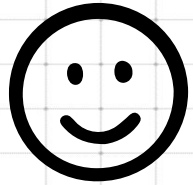

Both of these classes are 90 minutes long.

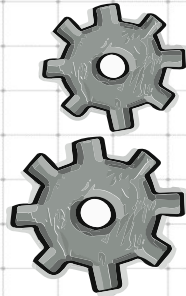
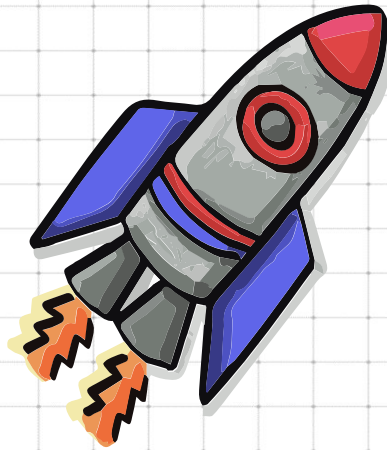
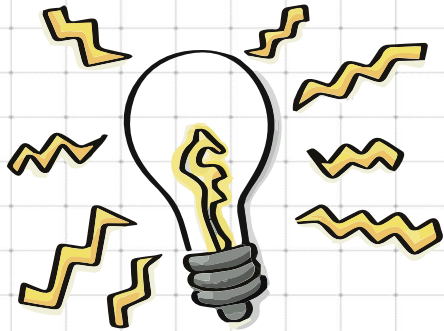
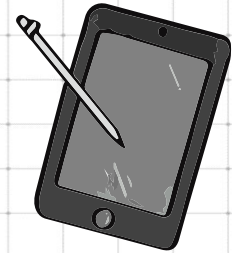

3. Limited number of fee waiver instruments. First come/first serve basis.

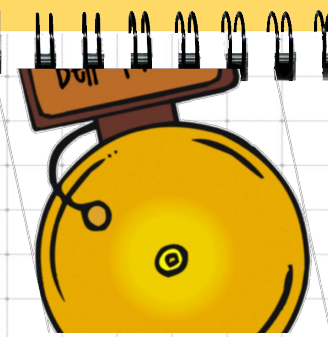


Lunch Procedures

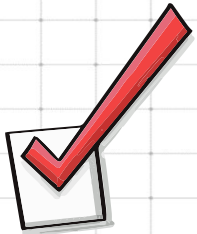
1. Students eat with their grade-level peers.

4. Activities include: Walk and Talk, Basketball, 4-Square, and Soccer.

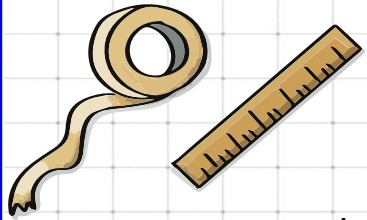


Dismissal Procedures

6. Parents must have a pick up plan with their students and students must check out each day following this plan.

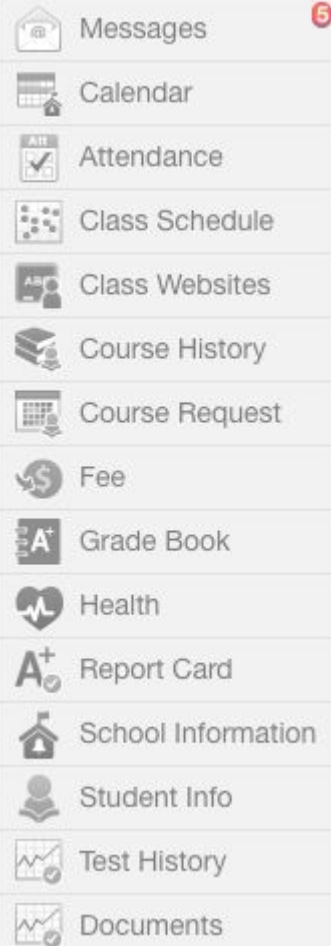

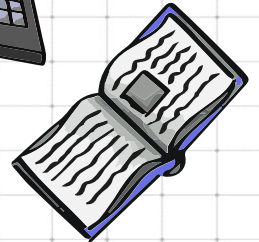
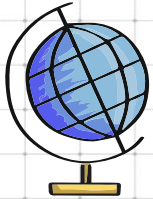
